Who should attend?

The Site Management Safety Training (SMSTS) course is designed for site managers and those who are, or are about to be, responsible for planning, organising, monitoring, controlling, and administering groups of staff and workforce.

Course Information

The CITB Site Management Safety Training Scheme (SMSTS) covers all relevant legislation affecting safe working in the building, construction, and civil engineering industries.

At the end of the course learners will be able to

- Implement all health, safety, welfare, and environmental legislation affecting daily work
- Implement new guidance and industry best practice
- State workers duties and responsibilities in regard to health, safety, welfare and environment

Entry Requirements

Learners should hold or be about to hold the role of a manager. Learners must be competent in English at site management level.

Learner Numbers

The maximum number of learners for this course is 20, with a minimum of 4.

Assessment

Learners' knowledge is assessed through an exam paper at the end of the course. Learners are also expected to actively participate during the course.

The examination lasts for 35 minutes and consists of 25 questions. The pass mark is 81% (26 out of 32). Should a learner fail the exam, re-sit options may be available.





Certification

Those who successfully complete the course will receive a CITB Site Management Safety Training Scheme certificate valid for 5 years.
