Who should attend?

The CITB Temporary Works Supervisor Training Course (TWSTC) is for those on site who are responsible for supervising temporary works.

Course Information

This course is designed to provide training for those undertaking the role of Temporary Works Supervisor as defined in BS 5975:2019+A1:2011.

Course Content

- The need for and duties of a Temporary Works Supervisor
- The role of others
- The BS5975 in respect of the Temporary Works Supervisor role
- The importance of the '4Cs' – Communication, co-ordination, co-operation and competency
- The need for risk management

Entry Requirements

There are no formal entry requirements for this course however, learners should hold or be about to hold the role of Temporary Works Supervisor.

Learner Numbers

The maximum number of learners for this course is 20, with a minimum of 4.

Assessment

Learners' knowledge is assessed through a multiple-choice exam paper at the end of the course. Learners are also expected to actively participate during the course.

The examination lasts for 30 minutes and consists of 25 questions. The pass mark is 72%. Should a learner fail the exam, re-sit options may be available.

Those who successfully complete the course will receive a CITB Temporary Works Supervisor Training Course digital certificate valid for 5 years.
