Who should attend?

The CPCS Slinger Signaller course is aimed at people who would like to gain entry into the lifting industry.

Course Information

Course Content

- Establish the weight and dimensions of loads and communicate this information to the crane operator.
- Select appropriate lifting tackle and attach and detach it correctly and safely.
- Use clear and unambiguous signals to direct the actions of a crane moving loads of various weights and dimensions.
- Determine the serviceability of lifting accessories and maintain and store them.

Entry Requirements

Learners must have passed the Operatives Health, Safety and Environment Test within the last 2 years, prior to their course start date.

Assessment

Mixture of classroom-based teaching and practical exercises, followed by CPCS technical tests.

Certification

For those who successfully complete the course and CPCS technical tests, they will receive a Red CPCS Trained Operator Card valid for 2 years.

After gaining on-site experience, learners must complete a Level 2 NVQ within two years to apply for the Blue CPCS Competence Card.
