Who should attend?

This programme is designed for the operators of MEWPs, those renewing their PAL cards or for those looking to learn how to operate MEWPs.

Course Information

Overview

With a small group size, the trainer will use a highly facilitative approach to the instruction, incorporating directive and participative methods. The main efforts must be practical in character, and they must include theoretical components to facilitate understanding. To improve training and capability outcomes, reflective practice and feedback strategies will be used.

Course Content

The IPAF Operator course with theory and practical training sessions and assessments covers the two powered access products, including Mobile Vertical (3a) & Mobile Boom (3b).

 - MEWP regulations and guidance
 - Machine types and use
 - Structural parts
 - Familiarisation and pre-use inspection
 - Safe operating methods and hazards
 - Practical training

Assessment

Learners' practical skills in utilising the equipment, as well as their understanding of how to use it safely, will be assessed. Only after passing both a theory and a practical test will they be able to obtain a licence to use MEWPs.

Certification

On successful completion of the course, learners will be issued a card and certificate in digital format via the ePAL app. The card and certificate are both valid for 5 years.
